- 3. Email the shelter at <u>admin@murphyskittens.org</u> one week prior to make an appointment to drop off donations.
- 4. Remember to thank those who donated to your donation drive!
- 5. Once we have received your donations, we will sign any required forms to verify the project and hours completed.
